

The purpose of WagsPark® & Daycare requirements is to provide a safe, fun, and stimulating environment for your dogs. To be able to ensure all of our dogs' safety and health, we require our guests to comply with the following requirements and regulations.

All dogs must pass a WagsPark® and Daycare temperament test before entering. All dogs must show proof of vaccinations: rabies, distemper, and bordetella. We recommend flea and tick medicine. All dogs must be spayed or neutered (Over 6 months old). It is recommended that your dog wear a quick release safety collar while in the park, and is mandatory for all dogs in daycare. No dog will be admitted with wounds, stitches, bandages, casts, head cones, or splints. Aggressive dogs are strictly forbidden. Any dog showing aggression towards humans or other dogs must be immediately leashed and removed from the park. Do not carry your dog around in your arms. No inhumane treatment of dogs allowed. Dog owners must maintain control over their dog at all times. Dog owners must remain with their dog at all times. No squeaky toys allowed in park at any time. Do not bring items that your pet highly values, like bones, favorite toys, ropes, etcetera, as they can lead to behavior that is overly protective and potentially unsafe. Do not bring items with your dog that are valuable or irreplaceable. We are not responsible for loss or damage to any personal items or toys in daycare or park. No food or dog treats of any kind in park. Keep in mind that throwing balls can create competition, jealousy, and spark fighting. Therefore park personnel reserve the right to restrict these activities should they deem them unsafe. Dogs involved in an altercation must exit the park immediately and remain outside the dog park, as well as complete an incident report.

Children & Adult Rules

Children under the age of 16 must be with an adult at all times. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted on the dock. Adults who cannot swim are not permitted on the dock. Children under the age of 16 must always be under direct adult supervision while on park property, and are to never be further than 10 feet from an adult. Children must follow all rules and not be allowed to destroy any property, including pulling on, standing on, leaning on any fence, park equipment, dog training equipment or any other assets of WagsPark®. Children are not permitted on any dog training equipment and are not allowed to run, scream, chase, play sports, or pet any person's dog. It isn't safe for small children to be in the dog park. Not all dogs are socialized with small children. Some dogs see small children (with their quick movements and small size) as prey. A child running may be seen as prey. Some herding dogs will attempt to herd your child. The dog may naturally herd with small nips to the back of the legs. Your dog may become territorial over your child. Other dogs may also become territorial over your child. This can cause a fight that could injure or scare your child. When dogs are playing, they naturally mouth, mount and may body slam. A dog may mistake your child for another playmate. Leashes must be with you at all times. No children's toys that may squeak are permitted. No sitting on the ground. No food of any kind in the park. No glass in the park. No smoking! Cigarettes can be lethal to dogs, particularly the butts, as they contain highly concentrated amounts of nicotine, a dangerous narcotic for dogs.

Alcoholic Beverage Policy

Members must be at least 21 years of age to purchase, possess or consume alcoholic beverages at WagsPark®. Valid state issued identification or valid driver's license is required upon each person purchasing, possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages. Any alcoholic beverage not purchased at WagsPark® is prohibited.

Terms & Conditions

1. I understand that I am solely responsible for any harm caused by my dog(s) while my dog(s) is attending WagsPark® and any events held there. I assume all responsibility and liability for any such loss or injury caused directly or indirectly to any person, animal or thing by the act of my dog(s).
2. I further understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s), WagsPark® has relied on my representation that my dog is in good health and has not harmed or shown aggression or threatening behavior towards any person or dog.
3. I further understand and agree that WagsPark® and their staff will not be liable for any problems that develop, provided reasonable care and precautions are followed, and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog(s) attendance and participation at WagsPark®.
4. I further understand, and also agree to defend, indemnify and hold WagsPark®, its members, officers, directors, employees, agents, attorneys, contractors, and their respective heirs, successors, executors, administrators, and assigns harmless against any and all claims, suits, costs, loss, damage, liability or expense that may arise against it by virtue of my dog(s) attendance and participation at WagsPark®.
5. I further understand and agree that my dog(s) is/are in good health and not ill with a communicable condition.
6. I further understand and agree that my dog(s) must be spayed or neutered, have up-to-date vaccinations that include rabies, DHPP (D = Distemper, H = Infectious Canine Hepatitis, P = Parainfluenza, P=Parvovirus) and Bordetella (Kennel Cough).
7. WagsPark® reserves the right to refuse admittance to any dog that does not meet the health and temperament requirements.
8. WagsPark® further reserves the right to amend, change, or create rules which will be posted online, and you agree to be bound by any changes, amendments, or new rules.
